

VERMONTVILLE TOWNSHIP  
FEBRUARY 22, 2010  
MINUTES

The Vermontville Township Board met in regular session on Monday, March 22, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. in the Opera House.

Supervisor Owens called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

Present: J Owens, B Miller, B Moore, J Nehmer and S Stewart.

Pledge to the flag.

There were two additions to the agenda; 1. Gene Fisher, representing the Maple Syrup Association and 2. Opera House Rental under new business. Motion by Stewart, support by Moore to approve the agenda with additions. All ayes. Carried.

Motion by Miller to allow the princess pageant to use the opera house for eight practices, two hours at a time, for the pageant and the public for non profit. Miller rescinded his motion.

Moore requested to remove bills from the consent agenda items and Miller stated he had a correction to the Special meeting minutes of February 11. Moore asked to remove payment to Judy Mohler, Deputy Treasurer, for \$52.50. He stated she should not be paid for training because the board did not give prior approval. Nehmer stated she is not required to get approval from the board to pay her deputy. Miller stated in the Feb 11, special meeting minutes, Owens motion concerning an assessor contracted v employee should have said: Motion by Owens to change Vermontville Township's assessor POSITION; not classification, to employee at the end of the current contract or April 1, 2010. Motion by Nehmer, support by Miller to approve Consent Agenda Items with corrections and additions. All ayes. Carried.

Motion by Moore, support by Stewart to advertise for letters of interest for anyone interested in serving as an alternate on the Board of Review. All ayes. Carried. Notices will be published in the Maple Valley News and County Journal; due by March 15, 2010.

Motion by Moore, support by Owens to let the Princess Pageant use the Opera House on Syrup Festival weekend and hours for practice for a community project for this township for this year. Miller stated he thought the use of the Opera House should be free to all residents. Vote revealed 4 ayes, 1 nay (Miller). Carried.

Motion by Stewart, support by Nehmer to adjourn. All ayes. Carried.
