

Vermontville Township Board
July 29, 2010
Minutes

The Vermontville Township Board met in regular session on Thursday July 29, 2010 at 7:00 pm in the Opera House.

Supervisor Owens called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Present: J. Owens, J. Nehmer, B. Moore and M. Grant, setting as deputy clerk

Absent: B. Miller and S. Stewart

Pledge to the flag.

Motion by Moore, seconded by Owens, to approve the agenda. All ayes.

Brian Peacock, Eaton County Sherriff Department, Monte O'Dell, Vermontville Township Fire Chief and Dan Sowles, Vermontville Township Ambulance Director all gave reports.

There were no business representatives.

Steve Wilbur introduced himself. He is running for Vermontville Village Council.

First public comment segment was heard.

Shirley Harmon gave the Vermontville Township Library report. Mike Hosey, Eaton County Commissioner, reported that Eaton County had balanced its budget and he was also asking for Vermontville Township residents to support the Eatran millage at Tuesday's election.

Nehmer asked that the minutes of July 14, 2010 be clarified stating that the assessor's salary included the \$500.00 stipend to certify the tax roll and that it was not extra to his salary.

Nehmer motioned, Moore seconded, to approve consent agenda with the change to the minutes. All ayes.

Several educational opportunities were shared during correspondence.

Owens reported that the latest tax tribunal was judged in favor of Vermontville Township. Moore shared his report from Fire and Ambulance Committee. No report from the Clerk nor the Treasurer. Moore reported that the office project

was coming along slowly. There was no representative from Greenways to share a report.

A Resolution to Approve the Ambulance Service language to go on the November ballot as a millage request was approved by a motion from Owens and seconded by Moore. A roll call vote was required. Owens – yes, Moore – yes, Nehmer – yes, Stewart – absent, Miller – absent. Motion carried.

FEMA flood information was tabled by Owens because more updated information had just become available.

There was no new business.

Second public comment was heard.

Nehmer motioned, Moore seconded, to adjourn. All ayes. Meeting adjourned at 7:55pm.
